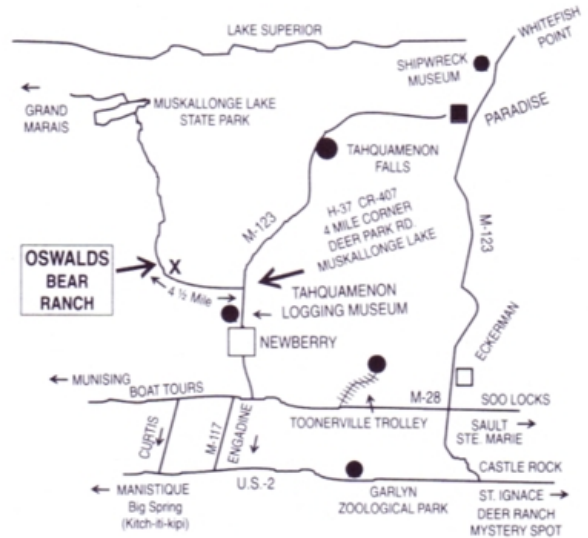

*We have raised bears here since 1984 and opened to the public in 1997. Michigan law prohibits breeding or buying of black bears. We rescue cub bears from all over the U.S.A. Once here, each bear will live its life here. The average bear lifetime is 25 to 30 years. Presently we have four natural habitats with trees, fresh running water to swim in and drink pools. This is an entirely family-run operation helping to keep the cost of admittance and souvenirs affordable for family entertainment.*
